Cosplay Headband Horns



Materials: Newspaper, masking tape, scissors, PVA glue, coloured yarn, headband, crafting wire, wire cutters, gloves (optional).

Taking your masking tape, and newspaper, tear out a page (to make A3), depending on the size of the horns you would like to make.

Begin shaping it, by scrunching and shaping it with her hands, balling up the "end" then twisting the horn tips.

Secure with tape.





Cover the horn in masking tape, it will help the horn keep its shape. Try and make the second horn in a similar style as your first one, they don't have to "match".

Choose what colours of yarn/wool you are going to use, then using PVA glue, pour or brush some onto the horn end/tip, and begin to wrap the different colours.







Glue down the sides of the horn and begin to wrap the wool/yarn down the horns.

Make sure you cover any gaps, wrap all the way down till you get to the end.

When you get to the end of the horn, you will need to pour more glue and circle the wool around it to cover the end.

Leave to dry upright.





Now let's start the steps to add the horns to the headbands. You'll need a hot glue gun, garden or craft wire, wire cutters, headbands, scissors and felt.

Now cut some wire, and folding over the wire so you two ends, make a circle of wire at the end, then twist wire to strengthen.

Before twisting ends to the headband, measure it against your head, to where you would like horns to go.





Try and make the wire parts be in similar lengths, but that is also up to what you have in mind for where you want your horns to sit.

Cut a felt circle that will cover the wire base at the bottom of the horns. Then put hot glue onto the wire circlet, stick on the horn, with the felt circle underneath, wire between.

We encourage you to cover hands with gloves or ask someone to help. Hot glue might burn if it touches your skins.





You can use the glue gun to cover any sharp edges of the wire wrapped around the headband. Then when the glue has cooled, you're horns are ready.

You can add other things to your headband, and change up the shapes and colours of the horns you choose or recreating the craft by modifying it.
