Folded Paper Stars



Materials needed: Hot glue guns, beads/sparkles (optional), coloured thin sheets of paper/tracing paper, scissors, fine and rock salt (optional), PVA glue.

Start by choosing what colour paper you would like to use, choose different sizes, like A4 and A3 to create different sized stars.

Fold vertically into either 2 or 4, then cut.






Now you need to fold the paper like you would when making a fan. Try to keep the folds even, we haven't been able, but we tried.


You will only need 2 folded pieces for each

Fold the fan folded paper in half and cut diagonally across from a corner.

Then use this as a guide to make sure all the ends are equal.

Hot glue the two halves in the middle of fold.





Repeat the above gluing of the sides together, remember you will only need 2 fan folded pieces.

Turn the star over and with a hot glue gun or PVA glue stick all the center edges together.

Optional: We decided to give our stars a "frosted" effect by painting them with PVA glue then either pouring a mixture of fine and rock salt over the gluey bits.

Then left them to dry before either adding the stars to bunting or other crafts.
