Snowflake Wreath




Tis the season to combine crafts onto a wreath!

Materials needed: Hot glue guns, beads/sparkles (optional), cardboard, newspaper, masking tape, different coloured tissue paper, pipe cleaner, hot glue snowflakes (craft on website), folded paper stars (craft on website).

<u>Note:</u> If using a hot glue gun make sure you're careful when handling it and wait till glue has cooled to pick off.

Start by finding a circle object that you think works best. Then trace around this onto the card with a pencil, then cut that shape out.

Do the same to the inner circle and cut out that shape too.





Now take some newspaper and ball it up then tape it to the cardboard. Fill the all the space.

Now gather the different coloured tissue paper you want to use and make a "milky -like" PVA glue to water mixture.

Grab a brush and paint this mixture over the taped newspaper, then gradually add tissue paper, layer the colours and cover with the mixture.

Then leave to dry.





We decide to draw snowflakes in different sizes and colours over the wreath base layer.

And wrapped the pipe cleaner over the "top" part (you decide which side is top or bottom).
