Hot Glue Snowflakes Art



Inspired from snowflake art that we always see as soon as the weather gets colder.

Materials needed: Hot glue guns, beads/sparkles (optional), plastic base/plastic binder, scissors, clear string.

Note: If using a hot glue gun make sure you're careful when handling it and wait till glue has cooled to pick off.

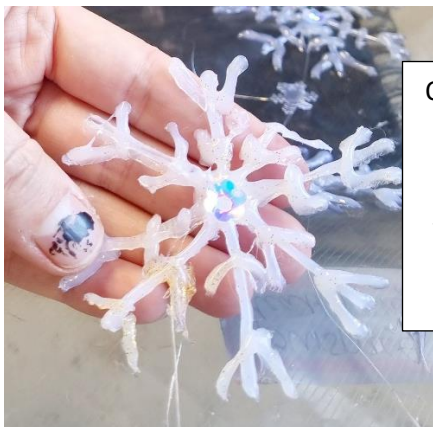
Place the plastic sheet/binder on top of the surface you'll be working on. Then wait till the hot glue is seeping out the end of the gun and begin to draw the shape of the snowflake.



We made a circle in the center then lines spreading out from this, then making arrow or "v" like shapes facing towards the center.

When drawing with the glue gun make sure to go over any lines that look a bit thin. Optional to glue the snowflakes onto the clear string.

Wait until the glue has completely cooled, then begin picking the snowflakes off.



Optional to add something sparkly in the center, or all over.

Have fun either making these into wreaths, or strings of snowflakes to decorate your home.
